- Registration fees for each semester are based on enrollment of 14 units per term, \$46/unit.
- Non-resident tuition** is an additional \$332/unit
- Personal/Misc. includes clothing, laundry, dry cleaning, personal care, recreation, medical, etc.
- Per Title V regulations, financial aid-eligible students cannot be charged more than \$20 per term for parking if they have been awarded a Fee Waiver (CCPG A, B or C). Regular parking fees are \$40 per semester and \$18 for the summer session.
- Less Than Half Time budgets** are based on the following:
 - Enrollment at 3 units per term, \$46/unit
 - Zero budget allocation for Food/Housing or Personal/Misc. Costs
 - Books/supplies and Transportation at 25% of ½ Time to Full Time Budgets
- Summer:** Food/Housing, Personal/Misc. Costs and Transportation are calculated by dividing the Fall & Spring total by 9 months, then multiplying by 2 months.
- Loan fees are an average of \$60 per loan.
