* **Media Studies Specialization:** Select 3 (9 units) from the courses identified with an asterisk. These 3 courses may not be taken Pass/No Pass (P/NP) and must be completed with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and a C or higher in each course. See the current SDSU catalog for additional information.

SDSU language graduation requirement: All require 3 semesters of foreign language or competency by successfully completing the third college semester on one foreign language.
