NOTE: A minor is not required with this major. Students are required to meet with their department adviser within the first two semesters after declaration or change of major.

There are two plans available for Comparative Literature majors. See the SDSU Catalog for more information.

Plan I: General literature. For students who do not intend to enter a graduate program in comparative literature.

Foreign Language Requirement: Competency (successfully completing the third college semester) is required in one foreign language as part of the preparation for the major. Refer to section of SDSU catalog on "Graduation Requirements."

Plan II: For students who intend to enter a graduate program in comparative literature.

Foreign Language Requirement: Coursework must include six units in a foreign language literature (read in the original language); and six units in another literature (which may be English or American) read in the original language. It is strongly recommended that even those students choosing English or American as their second literature attain competency in a second foreign language.
