

## **Grossmont College Math Department Definition of “Good Faith Effort”**

A “Good Faith Effort” on the part of a college math student will include, but not be limited to:

- 1) Taking and passing prerequisite or recommended preparation courses in sequence.
- 2) Obtaining all required materials for the course within the first week of class.
- 3) Maintaining almost perfect attendance (3 or fewer absences in a semester); 3 or fewer tardies or early departures.
- 4) Completing all required assignments and submitting them on time.
- 5) Using the Math Study Center on a regular, WEEKLY, basis.
- 6) Taking advantage of other available services on campus, such as the tutoring center, DSP&S, counseling, Career Center, etc.
- 7) Meeting a minimum of once every three weeks with the instructor during office hours, or other appropriate time, to discuss progress.
- 8) Maintaining a positive attitude toward the course.
