**El Cajon** - One of the oldest community college job fairs in the county continues with its 27<sup>th</sup> Annual Career Week and Job Expo at Grossmont College October 17. More than 100 employers and exhibitors are expected when the fair opens at 10 a.m. in the Main Quad. The event, which will close at 1 p.m., is free and open to the public for career exploration and job seekers. Many employers will be interviewing on the spot, so applicants are reminded to dress for the interview and bring copies of their resumes.

“This 27-year tradition has continued because of Grossmont College’s commitment to providing our students and the community the opportunity to explore the widest range of career options possible,” said Dr. Ted Martinez, Jr., college president. “This is also a tremendous opportunity for the college to enhance critical links with local business and industry.”

- **Thursday, Oct. 20 11a.m. to Noon**, a workshop will be held on “Administration of Justice Careers in Focus”. Guest panelists for this workshop include a Criminalist, a Drug Enforcement Agent and a Forensic Specialist. They will provide a close-up perspective on various career paths in Criminal Justice.
