**GROSSMONT COLLEGE ATHLETICS SUPPORT HURRICANE
KATRINA RELIEF – WILL DONATE HALF OF SATURDAY’S GATE**

El Cajon - As part of Grossmont College’s continuing commitment to support fundraising for Hurricane Katrina relief, the athletic department announces that half of the gate proceeds from the upcoming football game Saturday, September 17, as well as other contributions fans wish to make, will be donated to the student government relief effort.

The Grossmont College Griffins, ranked sixth nationally, will play San Jacinto Community College at 3 p.m. on the college campus in El Cajon. Admission is \$5 adults and \$3 for students with ID.

The Associated Students of Grossmont College (ASGC), along with honor society members of Phi Theta Kappa, are coordinating fundraising activities for hurricane relief. The ASGC is matching individual contributions up to \$3,000 received through the end of September. Proceeds are being forwarded to the Rescue Task Force.
