**GROSSMONT COLLEGE PROGRAM TO FEATURE
JAZZ LEGEND CLORA BRYANT MONDAY APRIL 11**

El Cajon - Jazz legend Clora Bryant, a strong force on the Los Angeles jazz scene and one of the greats of Central Avenue, will be featured in a free presentation Monday, April 11 at 7 p.m. in room 225 on the college campus. The subject of a new film documentary by independent filmmaker Zeinabu irene Davis, Bryant performed with such stars as Dizzy Gillespie and Billie Holiday during her 60-year career, but with little recognition.

Bryant will address the gathering and answer questions about her career and the making of the documentary. Davis, a UCSD professor, will discuss filmmaking and show excerpts from the documentary, "Trumpetistically, Clora Bryant," which is scheduled for release later this year.

Grossmont's music instructor Derek Canon, who provides the trumpet music in the documentary, will host the presentation which is designed for students and community members. The event is sponsored by the Grossmont College World Arts and Culture Organization.
