**El Cajon** - One of the oldest community college job fairs in the county continues with its 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Career Week and Job Expo at Grossmont College October 18. More than 100 employers and exhibitors are expected when the fair opens at 10 a.m. in the Main Quad. The event, which will close at 1 p.m., is free and open to the public for career exploration and job seekers. Many employers will be interviewing on the spot, so applicants are reminded to dress for the interview and bring copies of their resumes.

There will be special demonstrations by the San Diego County Sheriff's Department K-9 Unit and the landing of the ASTREA Helicopter at 11 a.m. in Parking Lot 5 on the college campus.
