<b>Charge</b>	<p>This committee will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Assess and recommend the use of appropriate educational technology for a more effective training and learning environment at Grossmont College.</li> <li>• Participate in developing, maintaining and implementing the college educational technology plan.</li> <li>• Participate in developing recommendations for the direction of technology for teaching and learning.</li> <li>• By means of a subcommittee on distance education, direct and implement the goals of the Academic Senate in the area of online education.</li> </ul>
<b>Meeting Schedule</b>	This may be adjusted as necessary to fit faculty schedules. For the 2007-8 academic year, the meeting will be on the 4 <sup>th</sup> Monday of the month from 11:00am-12:20 a.m.
<b>Chair</b>	The TTLC will vote for a faculty chair and send that person's name to the Academic Senate for ratification. The chair will serve for two academic years.
