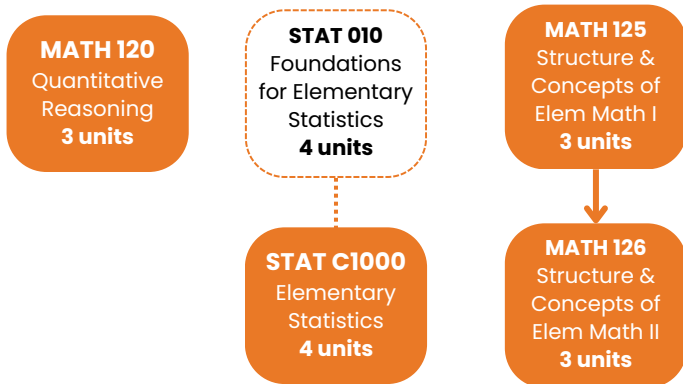


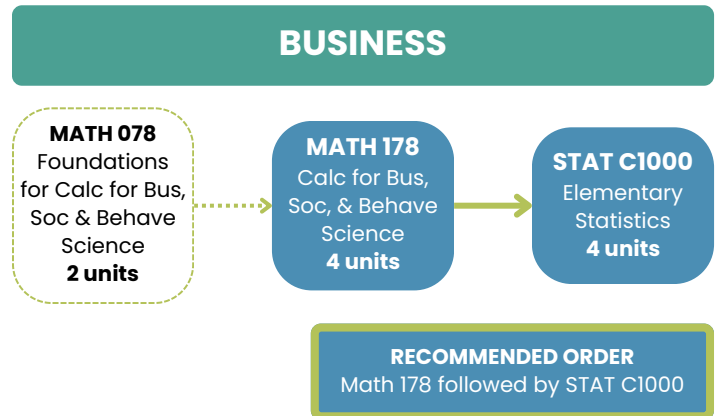

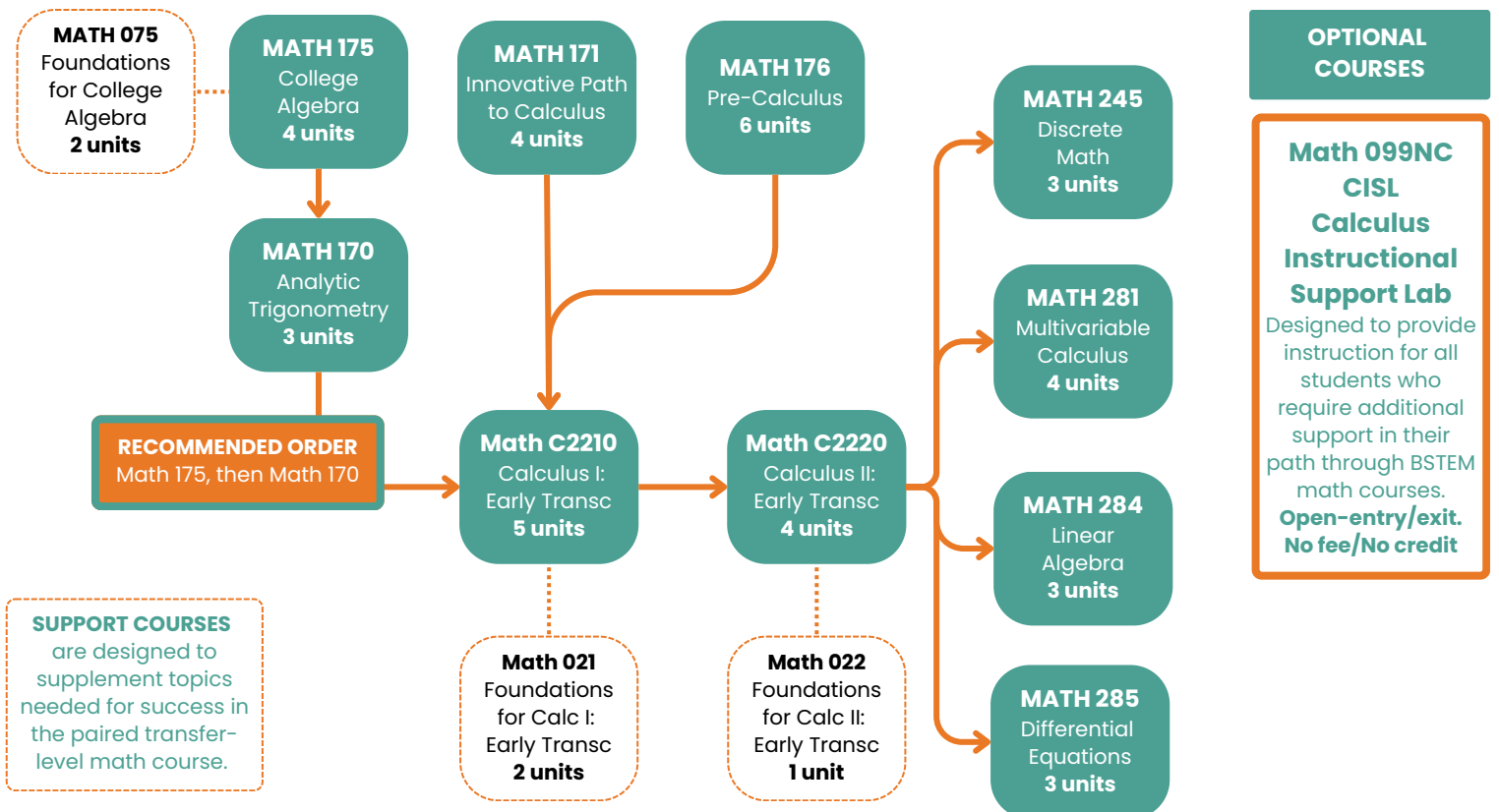

Math students can now enroll directly in Calculus I, Math C2210 with Support (Math 021). However, it's **highly recommended** that you start with the math course indicated by your placement questionnaire.

MATH PLACEMENT

All students have access to transfer-level math courses. Under AB 1705, you may enroll in any math course up to and including first-semester Calculus with support at Grossmont College.

Our placement process uses your high school GPA and the highest math course you have successfully completed.

To access the self-guided placement questionnaire, log into Self-Service and click on **Enrollment Checklist**, then click on **Click Here to Get Started**.

If you have completed a math class at another college, bring transcripts to the Counseling Center or submit an online Prerequisite Clearance Form.

Visit the Counseling Center to consult with a counselor about selecting the math course that aligns best with your educational goals.

HOW TO COMPLETE MATH PLACEMENT

Step 1: Log into **Self-Service** at selfservice.gcccd.edu

Step 2: Click on **Enrollment Checklist**

Step 3: Click on "Click Here to Get Started". You will find the questionnaire under the *To Do* modules – **Grossmont Placement Questionnaire and Abbreviated Education Plan**

Step 4: Review your recommended course(s). You may or may not be required to enroll in a paired support class.

SECTIONS WITH SUPPORT

- Students whose placement results indicate a need may be **required** to enroll in a concurrent support course paired with their transfer-level math class. The support courses provide extra instruction on prerequisite topics. All students are welcome to enroll in a support course even if it is not required.
- Courses with Support: STAT C1000 (Elem. Stats), Math 175 (College Algebra), Math 178 (Calc for Business, Social and Behavioral Sciences), Math C2210 (Calculus I), and Math C2220 (Calculus II).
- Also consider **Math 099NC CISL – Calculus Instructional Support Lab**, a free non-credit, open-entry lab for students in the Calculus sequence.
