# STEPS TO BECOME A NEW STUDENT

General Education course choices for transfer and the associate degree may differ between Cuyamaca and Grossmont College. Each college strongly recommends that students visit the Counseling Centers for specific information if they plan to attend both campuses.

## APPLY & ENROLL

### STEP 1: SUBMIT AN APPLICATION

Apply for admission if you have never been a student at Grossmont or Cuyamaca College or have not been in attendance for at least two consecutive semesters (re-admit) at either college.

### STEP 2: ORIENTATION & CAREER EXPLORATION

- Log into [Self-Service](https://selfservice.gcccd.edu). (<https://selfservice.gcccd.edu>)
- Under Orientation, Placement, and Advising select: **Step One - Online Orientation**

### STEP 3: ASSESSMENT & PLACEMENT QUESTIONNAIRE

Determine your placement level in Math and English, or ESL by taking the online guided self-placement questionnaire:

- Log into [Self-Service](https://selfservice.gcccd.edu)
- Under Orientation, Placement, and Advising, select: **Step Two - Placement Questionnaire**
- The questionnaire will determine if English language learners need to take the ESL Assessment.
- If the ESL Assessment is recommended, complete the online ESL self-guided questionnaire through the "Orientation, Placement and Advising" section.

### STEP 4: IN-PERSON/ONLINE ABBREVIATED EDUCATION PLAN

This is a one semester plan with recommended courses to take based on student's educational goals. You have two options to complete this step:

#### Option 1 (Online)

- Log into [Self-Service](https://selfservice.gcccd.edu)
- Under Orientation, Placement, and Advising, select: **Step Three - Online Advising**

*Note: In order to complete this step, you must have completed the online Placement Questionnaire.*

#### Option 2

Make a virtual or in-person appointment with a counselor on the [counseling center website](#).

### STEP 5: REGISTER AND PAY FOR CLASSES

You will be able to view your registration date/time and register for classes through Self-Service under the "Registration" menu. You can pay through Self-Service or the College Cashier's office located in Building 10.

### OTHER STEPS TO CONSIDER

#### **Request College Transcripts/Advanced Placement (AP) Test scores**

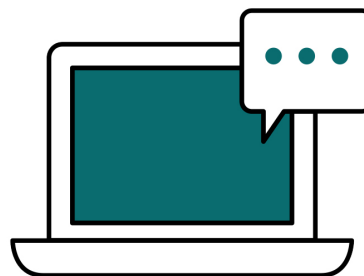


## Face-to-Face (F2F)

Face-to-face (F2F) course activity occurs at Grossmont College's campus or a designated physical site. The course meetings occur at scheduled days and times. Instructors may use a curriculum management system (Canvas) or other software to enhance the class (i.e. posting the syllabus or hosting a discussion board) outside of the on-campus meetings.

## Fully Online (FO) / Distance Education (DE)

Fully Online/Distance Education course activity occurs online and there are no required real-time or on-campus meetings. All content is delivered in a course management system (Canvas). Coursework has due dates as set by the instructor, yet can be completed at any time before the due date according to an individual student's schedule. Quizzes or tests may have a shortened period (usually a week's time) during which students will need to complete them. [grossmont.edu/online](https://grossmont.edu/online)

- **Marked "WEB" in the schedule for the location**
- **Asynchronous: Does not meet on specific days and times**
- **Synchronous: Meets on specific days and times**



## Partially Online (PO) / Hybrid (HYD)

Partially Online/Hybrid course activity occurs both online and face-to-face (F2F) on-campus. Both the online and on-campus portions are required. The on-campus meetings occur on scheduled days and times. All online content is delivered in a course management system (Canvas) and via online meetings (Zoom). [grossmont.edu/hybrid](https://grossmont.edu/hybrid)

- **Includes both F2F on specific days/times and "WEB" portions**
- **Read the course section details carefully**



## HyFlex

A HyFlex class section is taught on the same days and times, both on-campus and online. The instructor teaches this class section on campus while also engaging with students online. Students will have the flexibility to choose to either attend class in-person/on-campus or attend online via ZOOM. Some HyFlex sections may require in person class attendance for specific dates as listed in the schedule of classes. [grossmont.edu/hyflex](https://grossmont.edu/hyflex)





## REGISTRATION:

You will receive an email with your registration date and time. You will register online using self-service:  
<https://selfservice.gcccd.edu/student>

- Tip: Search the online class schedule and check for course prerequisites to make sure you are cleared ahead of time.
- Time conflicts are not allowed! You may not register for any section that meets on the same day and at the same time as another section you have selected.
- You may not enroll in two sections of the same subject.
- The maximum number of units you may enroll in is eighteen (18). To add additional units, you must contact counseling for an overload card. This card will be submitted by the Counseling Department to the Admissions and Records Office.

### WAITLIST PROCESS

Wait lists for all classes begin the instant that classes close due to full enrollment. You cannot be added to a wait list IF:

- It is prior to student registration appointment
- You are already enrolled, or on a wait list, in another section of the same class
- The wait list is full
- The class has started

Students are added to the wait list for a class on a first-come, first-served basis. As seats become available, students are automatically added to the class in which they are wait-listed.

You will not be added to a class IF:

- The class will cause a time conflict with another class on your schedule
- The class will cause you to go over the maximum number of units allowed
- Another section of the same course is already on your schedule
- You have a HOLD which prohibits registration

The student will be billed immediately once the student has been successfully moved from the wait list into the class and an email notice will be sent to the student email address on record. It is the student's responsibility to update all of their contact information in the Admissions and Records Office. To check and keep your information current, please use the Update Personal Information link under User Account on the Self-Service Student Menu. For students that were not registered from the wait list: (1) on the first day of class, instructors will determine the number of open seats; (2) spaces may be offered to students in the order their names were added to the wait list; (3) if a space is offered to a student, the instructor will give the student an Add authorization via Self-Service. Students are responsible for all fees generated from added classes; includes all forms of adds via web, moved from wait list, or by an add card. Students are responsible for monitoring their schedule and fees using Self-Service.

Students attending both Grossmont and Cuyamaca Colleges pay parking fees on ONE CAMPUS ONLY.

Students who depend exclusively upon prayer for healing in accordance with teachings of a bona fide religious sect, denomination, or organization are exempt from health fees.

Fees may be paid by Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, American Express, cash, personal check, cashier's check, or money order. Make checks payable to: GCCCD or Grossmont College. The student's ID number must be clearly written on the front of checks and money orders. Checks or credit card transactions returned by the bank will result in a \$10 returned item charge. Do not send cash through the mail.

### HOW TO MAKE A PAYMENT

You have two options to make a payment

#### **Option 1: via Self-Service**

Log in to self-service and click on Financial Information

- Select "make a payment" or "payment plan" to sign-up for a payment plan
- Flexible payment options available. No interest is charged; however, penalties will be applied for missed payments—\$30.00 fee if a payment is returned. For more information, call the Cashier's Office at (619) 644-7660.

#### **Option 2: College Cashier Office**

You can make a payment at the college cashier's office on campus, room 10-110.

## DROP/WITHDRAWAL

Withdrawal from a class shall be authorized through 75% of the semester. Students may drop classes through Self-Service. It is the student's responsibility to officially drop a class. Failure to withdraw/drop a class by the dates posted in the class schedule or webpage will result in failing (F) grade. If you need to drop a course, please refer to the class schedule or the Academic Calendar for important drop deadlines.

Please note drops/withdrawals may incur a repayment of financial aid funds. This is because Federal Title IV financial aid funds are awarded under the assumption that a student will remain in attendance for the entire semester and complete all classes for which Title IV funds or loans were awarded. ## REFUND INFORMATION

Refunds are made according to the refund schedules below and are available from the College Cashier's Office. You must present a valid government picture ID. To be eligible for a refund students are responsible to drop classes by the refund drop deadline. Classes dropped after the refund deadline either by student or instructor are not eligible for refund.

- Semester Length Courses: Refund for withdrawals through the first two weeks of instruction only
- 8 Week Courses: Refund for withdrawals through the first week of instruction only
- Any course less than 8 weeks: See A&R for the drop deadline date for your specific class
- Students who add a class after the drop deadline are not eligible for a refund
- Cash refunds are only payable to the student if paid by cash. There is a maximum cash refund limit set by the Cashier Offices
- Credit Card Refund: After 2-day processing period, a refund can be processed and posted back to the credit card used

For other student payments: Payment Plan, Wire Transfer, ACH, E-Check, Credit Card, etc. will be processed approximately the second week of the semester after the refund drop deadline. Monthly refunds will be issued until the end of the semester.

Refund checks will be issued to the address on record. Credit Card refunds will post to the credit card used. Credit Card refunds may also be initiated by calling the Cashier's office or stopping by in person (619) 644-7660.

\*\*For faster refunds remember to select a refund preference with BankMobile Disbursements, a technology solution, powered by BMTX, Inc.

### Student Benefit Card Refund:

The refund deadline date for the Student Benefit Card is consistent with the refund deadline for your class(es). Student Benefit Card refunds are available only if the card has not been used. After two weeks refunds are done through Student Activities, 619-644-7603.

### Refunds for Parking Permits:

You must physically return your parking permit to the College Cashier's office, WITHIN THE REFUND DEADLINE of your class/es to receive a refund. If you paid by credit card, we will process your transaction and you will receive a credit to your card from Credentials, Inc. If you paid by cash or check, we will refund your money to you after cancelling your parking permit through Credentials, Inc.

## FINANCIAL AID

We believe everyone should have the chance to go to college, regardless of their financial or living situation. Get the support you need to earn a degree, certificate, or important job skills.

### Federal Aid

Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at <https://studentaid.gov> or a CA Dream Act application (if you are a Dreamer) at <https://dream.csac.ca.gov>.

Please be sure to list all appropriate colleges with correct addresses (no abbreviations). **Grossmont College's Title IV school code is 001208.** Do not submit your FAFSA for the next award year prior to October 1st. Read the instructions carefully. Accuracy is very important. The FAFSA must be filed annually.

### College Promise

The Grossmont-Cuyamaca College Promise offers up to 2 years of free tuition and mandatory fees for qualifying California residents or eligible AB540 nonresidents in the Fall and Spring semesters!

The Promise does not have an application process, there are no forms to submit, and no income requirements.

Students who apply to Grossmont or Cuyamaca College and meet the requirements below, by the semester deadline, will be considered for the Promise. Deadlines and additional information can be found online at <https://www.gcccd.edu/promise>

## California Promise - formerly known as Board of Governors (BOG) Fee Waiver

The BOG Fee Waiver program has changed its name to the California College Promise Grant. The general criteria has not changed and the program will still provide the same benefits to approximately 1 million students in California. This program waives the enrollment fee for residents of California and students eligible under the provisions of the California Dream Act (effective January 1, 2013) who have financial need. Students are automatically considered for the fee waiver as part of the financial aid application process by completing the FAFSA or CA Dream Act application or by completing the on-line California Promise Grant fee waiver application. ## **PUBLIC SAFETY**

### **POLICE SERVICES**

District police services are provided by the San Diego County Sheriff's Department. Deputies are assigned to the Grossmont and Cuyamaca college campuses. If necessary, the District also has access to Sheriff's Department specialized units that investigate crimes such as illegal drug sales, domestic violence, auto theft or gang-related crime. In addition, a team of Campus and Parking Services (CAPS) specialists provides services such as automobile assistance, lost & found, and safety escorts. CAPS also enforces parking regulations on campus. The Public Safety / CAPS Office is located in the Grossmont College parking structure, Room 57-100.

### **STUDENT AND VISITOR PARKING PERMITS**

Student parking permits are required Monday through Saturday. Student and visitor parking spaces are free on Sunday. Parking permits are only valid in student and visitor spaces. California parking regulations are enforced year-round, including during holidays, spring break, weekends, and summer sessions. Restrictions include, but are not limited to, parking in a fire lane, staff parking, disabled placard misuse, and timed spaces. Vehicle owners are solely responsible for any loss, damage, or theft that occurs to their vehicle while parked on District property. All vehicles must be parked between two demarcated lines, and overnight parking is not permitted on campus after 11:00 p.m. Student parking permits may be purchased through student self-service or on the Public Safety webpage. Visitor permits may be purchased using the link on the Public Safety webpage: <https://www.gcccd.edu/public-safety/>.

### **PARKING & TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

All vehicles must have a valid college parking permit while parked on campus property. The responsibility of finding a legal parking space, as well as knowing where and when a parking permit is valid, rests with the vehicle operator and/or owner. The purchase of a parking permit does not guarantee a space to park. For the safety of the college community, all California Vehicles Codes

are enforced. All community members (students, staff, faculty, and visitors) are primarily responsible for their own safety and property. For further information, contact the Campus and Parking Services at (619) 644-7654.

### **REPLACEMENT FOR LOST OR STOLEN PERMITS**

There are no refunds or replacement of lost or stolen parking permits.

### **MOTORCYCLE PARKING**

Motorcycles, scooters, segways, and mopeds must be parked in designated motorcycle areas. Motorcycles parked in auto parking spaces are subject to citation.

### **ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS**

Bicycle racks are available throughout campus.

The college Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) pass is a great way to avoid parking hassles, car expenses, and to have access to unlimited rides throughout the semester. Semester MTS passes are available at the Cashier's Office, G-100 building, window. ### **MOTORIST ASSISTANCE**

The Campus Safety goal is to provide safe, orderly, and fair parking to the college community. We strive to make parking on either campus as convenient as possible, while promoting safe movement of vehicles and providing for pedestrian safety. All persons with a valid parking permit are eligible to receive the following complimentary services: unlocking vehicle and battery jump start.

### **REFUNDS FOR PARKING PERMITS**

A refund request must be made within 2 weeks of the semester start. Email [District.Parking@gcccd.edu](mailto:District.Parking@gcccd.edu) for a request.

### **DISABLED PLACE CARDS**

All students displaying a valid and current disabled placard are not required to display a GCCCD parking permit. Placard misuse will be heavily enforced and a CAPS specialist may ask to see your placard and registration at any time. Please be prepared to show proof of ownership when requested by a Parking Services Specialist.

### **PARKING CITATIONS**

Parking citations vary between \$45 to \$500 per violation and can be paid or appealed online by visiting [www.paymycite.com/gcccd](http://www.paymycite.com/gcccd).

If the citation is not paid within 21 days, the fine will increase by \$75. After 45 days, the citation will be reported to the state Department of Motor Vehicles, which will not renew your registration until the fine is paid. All disputed fines are individually reviewed by a non-biased representative in the Campus and Parking Services office. You will be notified of the outcome of your appeal for a parking citation.

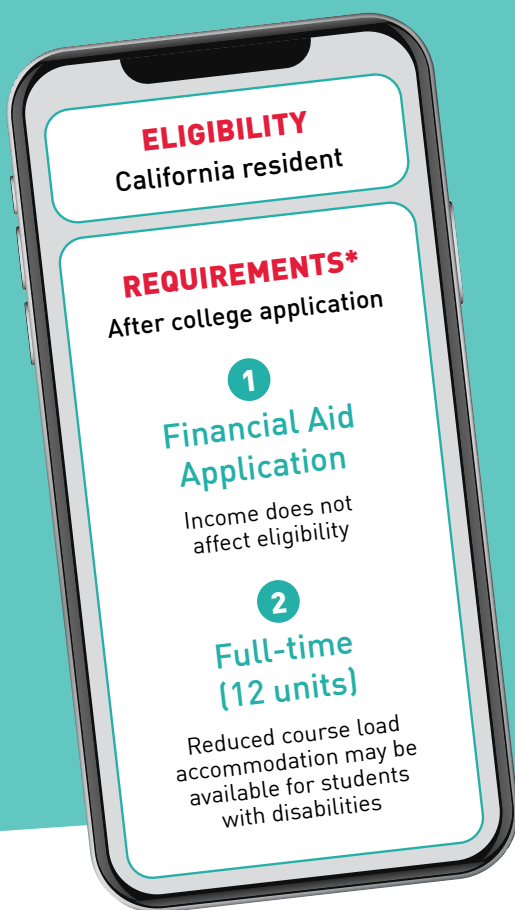

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### 1 WHEN IS THE PROMISE DEADLINE?

Two (2) weeks after the start of the semester. The semester deadlines are listed on the [mycollegepromise.net](http://mycollegepromise.net) website.

### 2 HOW ARE TUITION AND FEES PAID THROUGH THE PROMISE?

After registering for classes, there are two (2) ways the Promise can pay your tuition and mandatory fees.

#### OPTION 1: Do NOT PAY at the time of registration.

Tuition and mandatory fees will be **paid for by the Promise**, after the deadline. Students can attend classes and will not be dropped for nonpayment.

#### OPTION 2: PAY at the time of registration.

Tuition and mandatory fees **will be automatically reimbursed**, after the deadline.

### 3 WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE PROMISE?

Students who are CA residents or AB540 are eligible. The Grossmont-Cuyamaca College Promise is not just for recent high school graduates. There is no age limitation.

### 4 IS THE PROMISE ELIGIBILITY DETERMINED BY INCOME?

No. Students must complete a Financial Aid Application (FAFSA or Dream Act), but do not have to qualify for Financial Aid to be eligible to receive the Promise.

### 5 DOES THE PROMISE PAY FOR SUMMER CLASSES?

No. However, grades from Summer classes will count towards maintaining a cumulative 2.0 GPA requirement.

### 6 CAN STUDENTS START IN THE SPRING AND RECEIVE THE PROMISE?

Yes, and if eligibility requirements are maintained, they would be eligible for the following Fall and Spring semesters (2nd year).

### 7 WHEN ARE STUDENTS NOTIFIED IF THEY ARE AWARDED?

Two weeks after the semester deadline, via email.

### 8 HOW DO I CONTINUE TO REMAIN ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE PROMISE EACH SEMESTER?

Students must (1) maintain full-time (12-units, or reduced units for students approved for disability accommodation); (2) maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA; and (3) submit the Financial Aid Application (FAFSA) each year. If each requirement is not met, students will no longer be awarded the Promise.

# Eligibility Criteria for The California College Promise Grant (formerly known as the Board of Governors Fee Waiver)

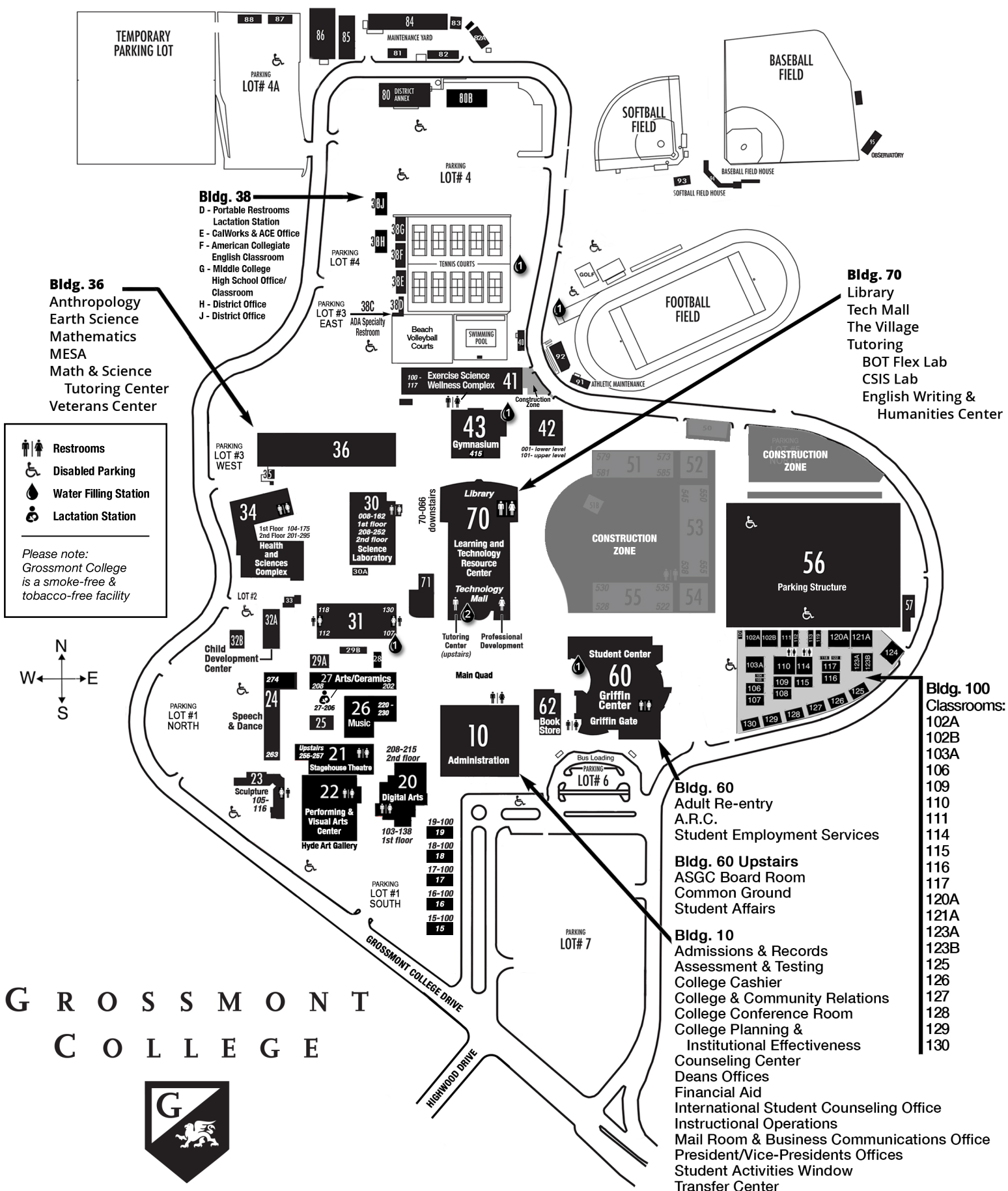
