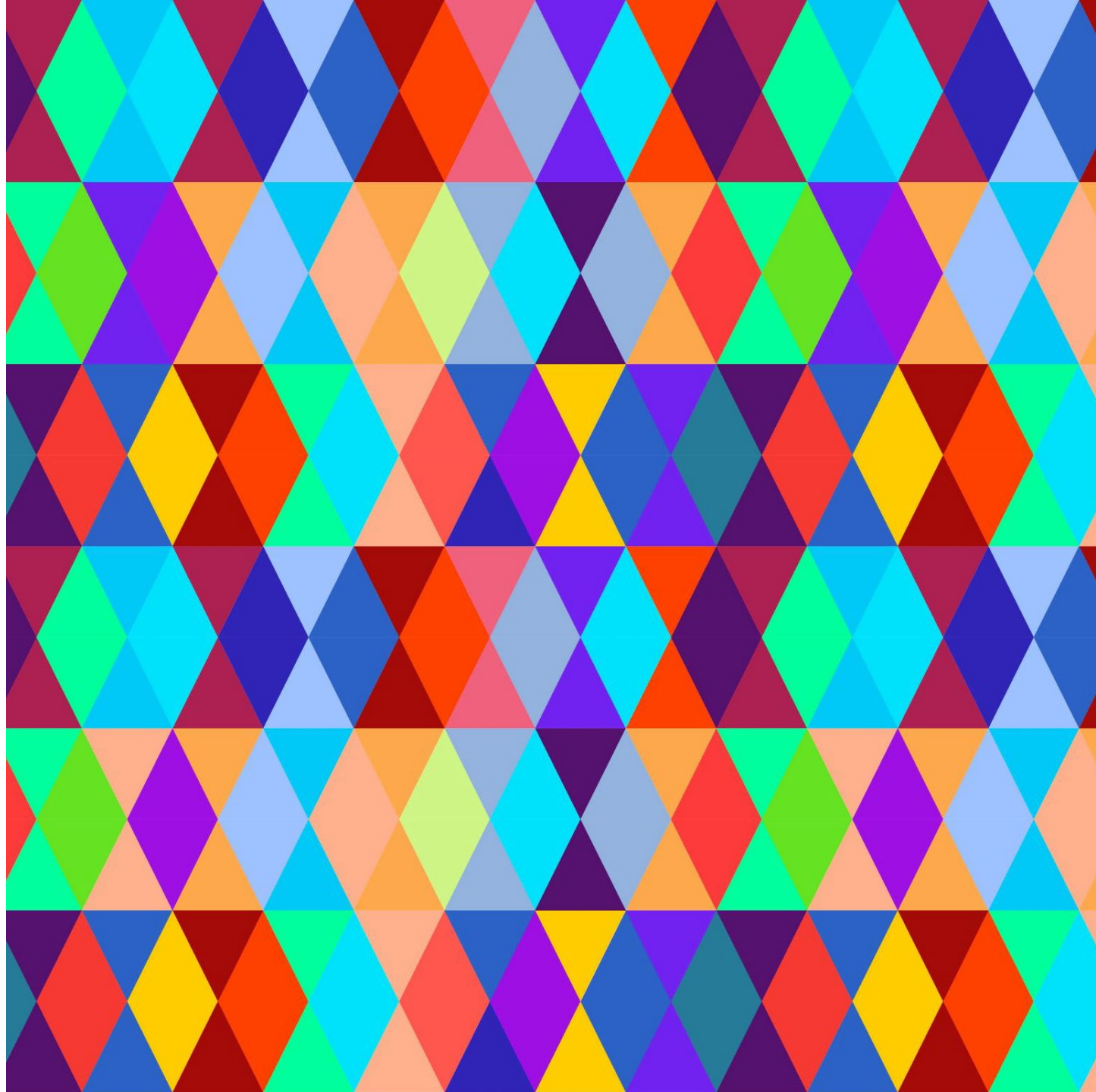

Institutional Effectiveness

ACCJC Requirement: Use results of outcomes assessment to continuously improve.

ACCJC Standard I: Institutional Effectiveness

- + I.B.2: The institution defines and assesses student learning outcomes for all instructional programs and student and learning support services. (ER 11)
- + I.B.4: The institution uses assessment data and organizes its institutional processes to support student learning and student achievement.
- + II.A.16: The institution regularly evaluates and improves the quality and currency of all instructional programs offered in the name of the institution, including collegiate, pre-collegiate, career/technical, and continuing and community education courses and programs, regardless of delivery mode or location. The institution systematically strives to improve programs and courses to enhance learning outcomes and achievement for students.

Regular and Substantive Interaction

About 90% of our courses demonstrated RSI (up from roughly a quarter of courses)!

SLOs in Syllabi

Almost 100% of our courses had accurate SLO information (up from less than half)!
