9.1	<p>College President Update – Dr. Denise Whisenhunt Due to schedule conflict, presented prior to Curriculum Committee (8.2.2). Gave update on commencement. Plan is to hold it at Grossmont College. Looked at numerous locations around the county but did not work out. Will hold earlier in the day due to weather. Faculty prioritization list forwarded to College Council. Nine positions approved. Five will be hired this Spring and the remainder will be hired next year. Dream Center Counselor/Coordinator, Visual Arts Sculpture, Biology, Mental Health, Theatre Arts. Update on ongoing requirements regarding masking on campus. Still required in buildings.</p>

9.2	<p>Self-Service Upgrade – Kerry Kilber & Barbara Gallego</p> <p>Information shared regarding features on Web Advisor that will need to be transitioned to Self-Service sooner than expected – April 20 (presentation in attachments). This will impact several rosters that faculty use. Pilot test group comprised of faculty practiced and found the process easy to use. Two rosters will stay on Web Advisor until Fall (Grading for positive attendance and Drop Roster). Trainings for all faculty will be available beginning March 28 on Zoom and in-person trainings will also be available. An instructional manual has been developed. During peak times, live support will be available.</p>
