We are a home college as of 1/31/23.


Students at Grossmont may take courses through the CVC Course Exchange at other CCC Teaching Colleges.

### What is POCR?



- Established in 2014 by California Virtual Campus (CVC)
- Voluntary
- Involves faculty working in peer groups to review their courses, offer feedback, and make course revisions
- Reviewers evaluate their peers' courses in small groups using the <u>CVC</u> <u>Course Design rubric</u> (44 in total)
  - Course Design
  - Interaction
  - Assessment
  - Accessibility

Instructors who align their course with the rubric criteria earn a Quality Review Badge



### How?



#### Goals:

- GC Senate endorsement of POCR
- Incorporate the <u>Peralta Online Equity Rubric</u> into the review process to increase equity in our online courses
- Establish a POCR Lead
- Create POCR Review Team (<u>60 hour POCR training course for individual certification</u>)
- 5. Identify three courses to review
- 6. When three courses are locally reviewed and "aligned," courses are sent to state for approval. When approved, GC would then have a local POCR certified campus
- 7. Review, approve, and badge additional courses
