# Big Picture

## Catalog Rights

### Goal:

- Clarifying the language
- Including the three public segments of CA
- Ensuring a student centered policy

## Retroactive Awards

### Goal:

- Include the practice in the catalog for visibility and transparency to students
- Make it simple for students

## Continuous Enrollment

### Goal:

- Clarify under what conditions continuous enrollment is achieved
- Include the summer term as one that could establish and maintain enrollment



## Catalog Rights (continued)

- Our students are students of the state
- Ethnic Studies - Area F, Area 7
- California Virtual College

Ultimately, updating our policy allows for GCCCD to welcome students and not interrupt their progress with a restrictive policy.

# Big Picture

## Catalog Correction

Goal:

- Alignment with T5
- Allowance for use of P grades in the major is allowed

## ADTs

Goal:

- The ADTs, created for transfer, can use P grades in the major
- Our local standard was higher than the transfer degrees

## Message to students

Goal:

- Clarify the need for guidance
- P/NP policy is now updated and students can elect the option through the last day of instruction



## P/NP (continued)

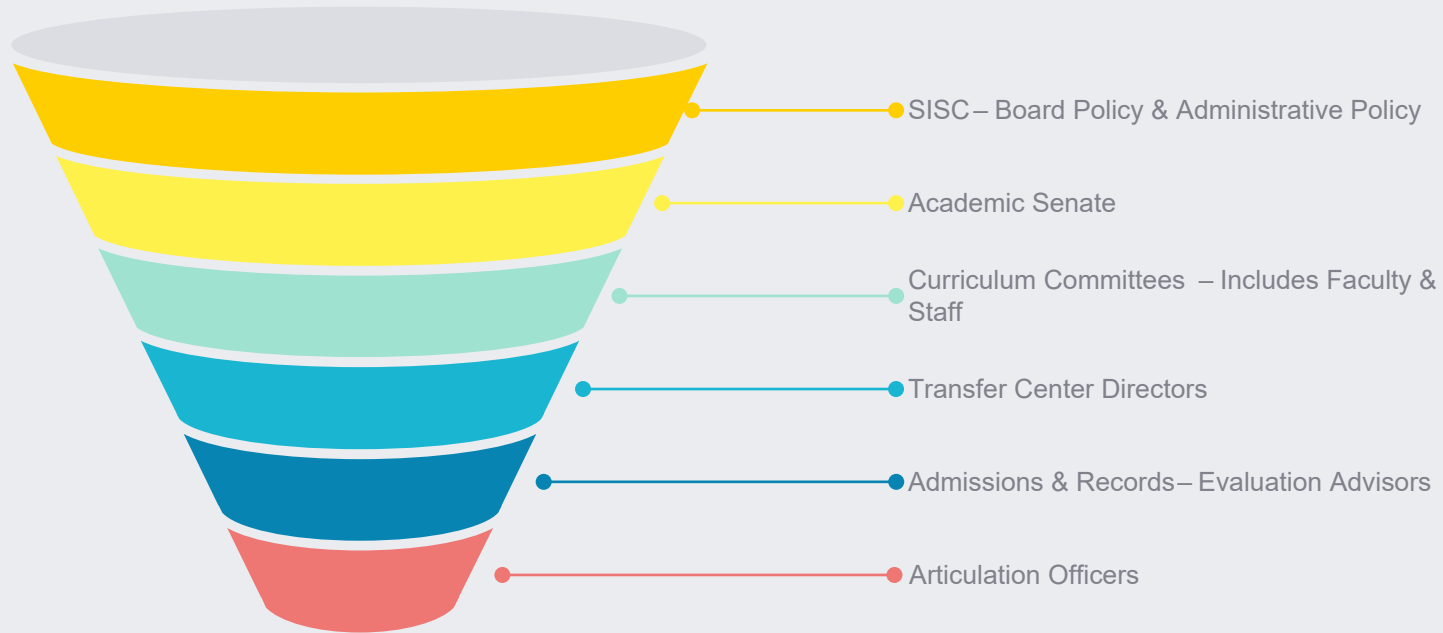
- Provides one standard for all degrees
- Removes an additional process required to achieve the same outcome, MOM
- Counseling and advising for majors would remain consistent – transfer requires research

Ultimately, updating our policy allows for students to utilize “P or C” grade or above coursework in the major with out additional hurdles.
