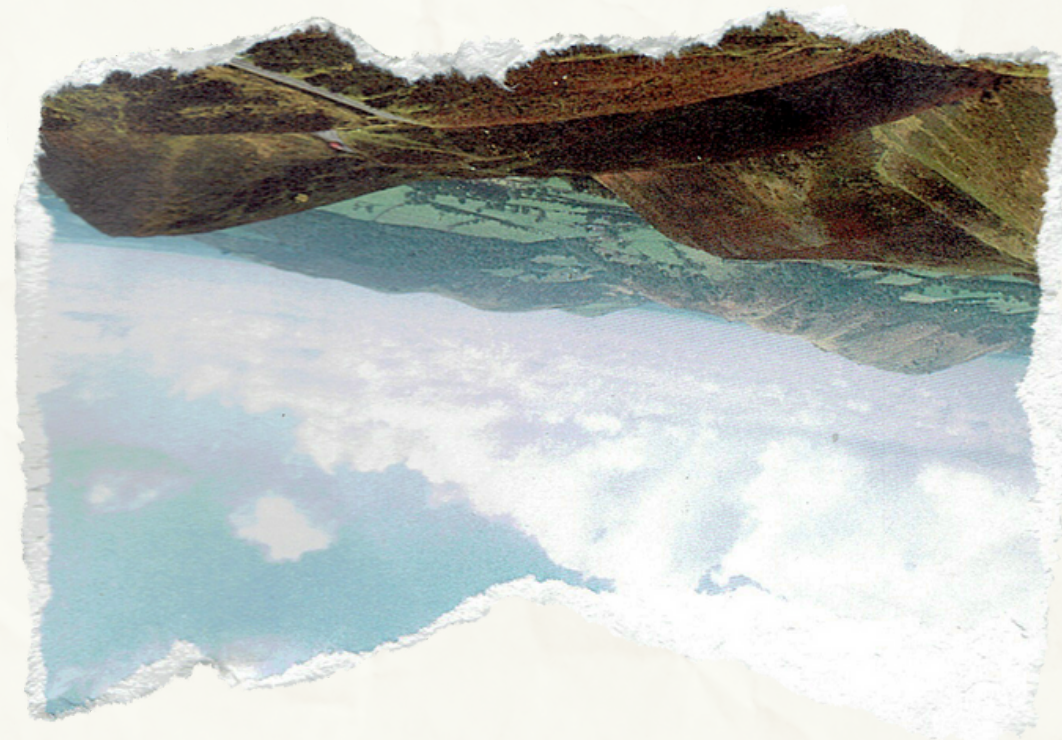
CalFresh is a monthly benefits program for food. If you're a student enrolled half-time or more, you might be eligible for CalFresh if ONE of the following apply:

- Work 20 hours/week; or an average of 80 hours/month
- Awarded work-study during the current academic year
- Approved for TANF-Funded Cal Grant A or B
- Care for a child under the age of 6
- Be enrolled in an approved Career and Technical Education Program (Coming Fall 2022!)

Applying online takes just a few minutes and if approved, you'll get money to purchase groceries via an Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) card every month that you are eligible.

Case Management

Case management plays a critical role in ensuring that individuals receive appropriate and timely services by addressing social determinants of health, such as housing, food insecurity, and access to both on and off campus area resources
