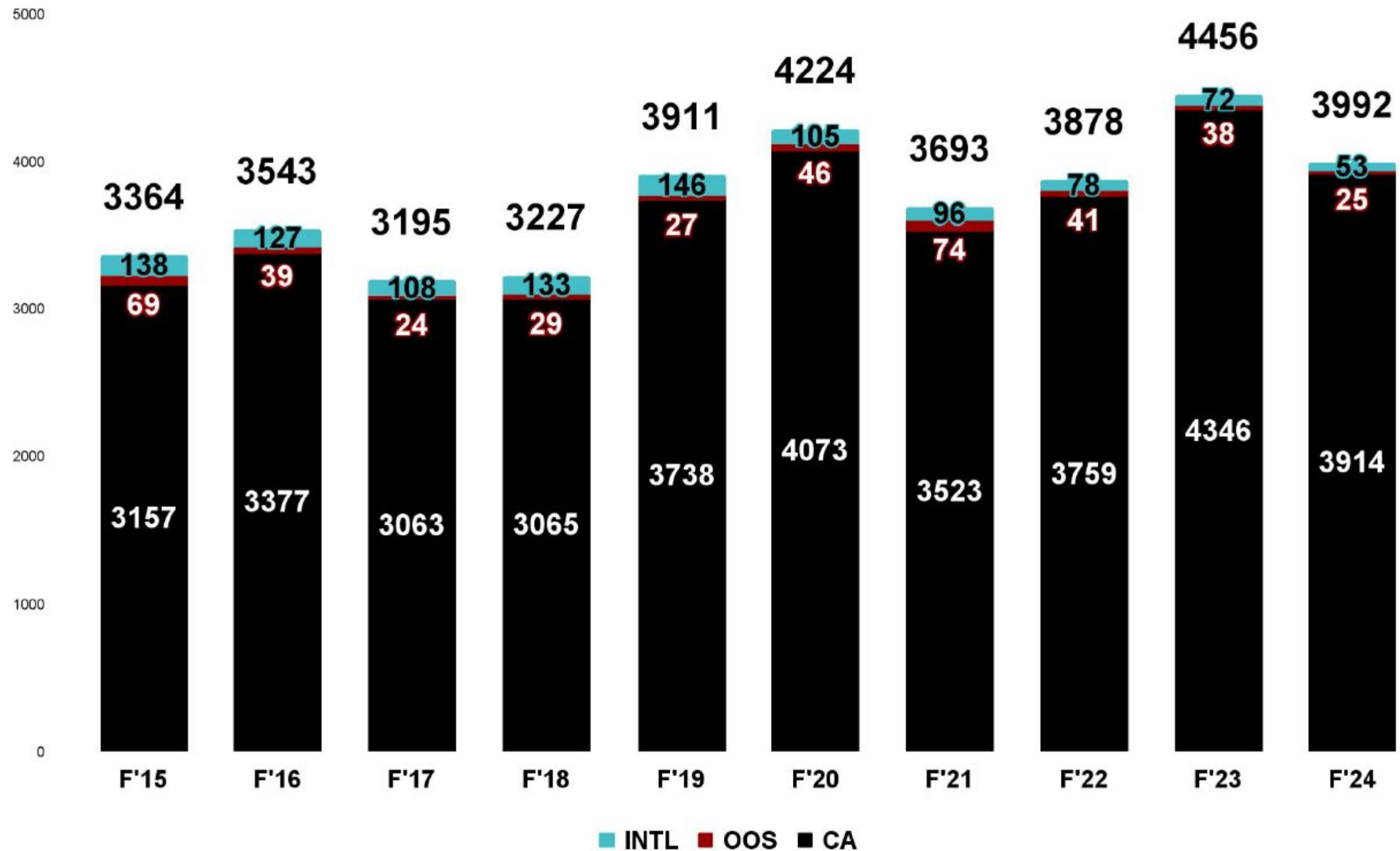

- Our admit and enrollee numbers have remained stable over the last four years despite effects of the pandemic.
- Of the top three sending schools, when looking at percentage of applicants that were offered admission: Grossmont 79.7%, Mesa 73.9%, Southwestern 70.6%
