3. Approval of 5/19/23 Meeting Minutes	The 5/19/23 meeting minutes were approved.	
 4. Committee Report Outs College Council PIEC Student Success & Equity Budget Facilities 	College Council – Michele Martens, Diana Barajas, Cindy Emerson, Elaine Adlam Diana stated College Council approved the Governance Handbook with a few changes. The charge of the Budget committee is going back to the original wording so that the committee can reassess in the fall. Co-chairs will now be a two-year term, starting in 2024/25. There was a question on what would happen with those representatives with three year terms. It was suggested bringing this up with the consultants at the governance refresher. They also approved the raising of the pride flag request. The resolution for ASGC students to get priority registration was not discussed.	
	PIEC- Steven Miller, Graylin Clavell, Juliana Bertin They just had their final meeting. Juliana Bertin will be the co- chair starting in the fall. PIEC will begin planning this fall for the annual forum next spring. They are also reviewing the exit survey from the planning forum this year.	
	Student Success and Equity – Michele Martens, Andrew Hellier, Janet Shipstead The focus was on equity and what that looks like. They looked over the progress we had made given this is the first year in our Student Equity Plan. The progress report was shared which reviewed the initiatives and action steps to bring about these changes. It also reviewed the goals that were created a year ago and what we accomplished so far. There are many areas throughout the campus that might be meeting some of these goals, so the committee is going to make a standing agenda item and invite people from departments to share what they have been working on in equity and the strides they made. The committee also wants to create a definition of equity so the common definition can be used across campus.	
	They also talked about the Governance Refresher in August which is intended for chairs, co-chairs, notetakers, and constituent representatives. It will then be shared out with groups from there. A survey was sent out to governance committees. That feedback will be sent to our consultants. Lastly, another goal is to create employee handbooks for various positions.	
	Budget – Janet Shipstead, Juliana Bertin, Dawn Heuft The consultant seemed optimistic about the budget. Juliana stated that if you are interested in seeing the budget documents, send her an email and she will forward.	
	Facilities – Rochelle Weiser, Chad Deitchman The committee looked over the new form for facilities requests and updating it in the AUP. There was a proposed change in the resource request form to make it more in depth to help with cost.
