Figure 1 shows how to determine the correct surrounding space guidelines.





Examples of Incorrect Signature (Logo+Logotype) Usage



Incorrect 1. Do not switch the Grossmont colors Pantone 329 and black.

Incorrect 2. Do not switch the Grossmont colors Pantone 329 and black.

Do not use a different typeface for the Grossmont College Logotype.

Incorrect 3. Do not use the Grossmont College Logotype separate from the Logo.

Incorrect 4. Do not <u>distort</u> or <u>stretch</u> the Signature in any degree or direction.


Incorrect 5. Do not use colors for the Signature other than those specified (Pantone 329 *or* CMYK 100/0/38/47 *or* RGB 51/90/92).

Incorrect 6. Do not delete parts of the Signature.

Incorrect 7. Do not change or modify any piece or portion of the Signature.

Incorrect 8. Do not create an outline of the Signature.

Incorrect 9. Do not change the size relationships within the signature.



Incorrect 10. Do not change the space between the Logo and Logotype within the Signature.

Incorrect 11. Do not reverse the order of the Signature (Horizontal Lock-Up).

Incorrect 12. Do not flip the Logo and Logotype (Vertical/Centered Lock-Up).

Incorrect 13. Do not change typefaces in the Signature (Horizontal Lock-Up).

Incorrect 14. Do not rotate the Signature.

Incorrect 15. Do not use the Signature on a busy or patterned background.

Signature - Vertical/Centered Lock-Up

The Grossmont College Signature *Vertical/Centered Lock-Up* is to be used as the college's primary identifier. Whenever applicable, the *Vertical/Centered Lock-Up* should be used as prescribed in the above usage sections.

This *Vertical/Centered Lock-Up* is to be used as one of two orientations of the Signature and is considered preferable except in cases of size or proportion restrictions.

Signature - Horizontal Lock-Up

The Grossmont College Signature *Horizontal Lock-Up* is to be used as the college's secondary identifier. The *Horizontal Lock-Up* serves as a second option to the *Vertical/Centered Lock-Up*. In cases of size or proportion limitations, the *Horizontal Lock-Up* may offer increased legibility or a more practical use of available space.
