1. **Call to Order** – Aceves called to order at 2:05pm

ESL

Course Additions: 108

- Committee reviewed supplemental explanation provided by ESL
- Calo/Sampson motion to approve discussion of the course
- Comments:
 - Fulbright: What is the purpose of the course? Does it seem student centered?
 - Sampson: Would like representatives from ESL to explain.
 - Kalker: Didn't hear original presentation. After reading explanation, it sounded student centered and based on student requests. Acknowledges concerns about adding units, but leaning towards yes.
 - Fulbright: What do students need vs what are they requesting? At what point do we let go and let them walk on their own since they have proved a level of proficiency. Do they need this type of additional support at this proficiency level?
 - Barrow: Heard faculty presentation and read explanation, but not convinced. Even today, not sure what the clear message is for the course.

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- Aceves: This is an elective course that they can enroll in if they are not able to get into another. ESL courses are eligible for financial aid, and students might not be aware of that. ESL can absorb much of their financial aid, which can impact them later on in their academic pathway. Creates a barrier when they max out of units to reach their goal (e.g. max unit petition).
- Kalker: Is the course 6 units or 3 units?
- DiDomenico: It is a 3 unit course. Is there another class a student can take besides this?
- Fulbright: Any other class that transfers. If the goal is to get them to transfer level then they need to get into those classes. They still have ability to take other courses, just not a full load of ESL.
- Cormier: Did faculty explicitly say students are not comfortable taking courses outside of ESL? This is a level 4, so they should be able to.
- Fielden: Met with an ESL student yesterday and they placed in transfer level. However, student does not want to because they didn't feel confident and worried about not being prepared. He can understand wanting to have a course like this available, but also understands argument about unit increase. Have they considered this as a credit/no credit option?
- Aceves: If this course doesn't get approved, it is an option to consider
- Sampson: On the topic of confidence, we have it in our job descriptions that English is a requirement. This is an example of the types of messages that are sent to students that can affect their confidence. It is our exclusionary practices that we need to switch to give students confidence to succeed in these courses.
