Objectives for this Semester

Website Development

Degree Mapping: Next Steps

- (September) Gary has drafted degree maps for all 26 ADTs to be shared with departments.
- (Starting in October) GP leadership team will reach out to department chairs to develop a plan for sharing maps.
- (Starting in November) Degree Map classes will be entered in a fillable form by Department Chairs or GP Leadership Team.
- **Goal:** To have 50% of ADT degree maps entered into fillable form by the end of the semester


