

Q1 - At which college do you take classes?





Plus but I don't search by ztc







I haven't received my financial aid for the semester, so I paid for my books and codes myself.


It depends sometimes it does cover it & sometimes I have to pay out of pocket.

Q9 - This semester about how much money did you spend on textbooks for all of your




