1	FPR 2021-02 Bio Stools	Replace 12-year-old stools with new ones that include backs for student comfort	The stools are not ergonomic friendly because they do not have backs on them. These labs can be three hours long and can fatigue the students in their learning experience.	
2	FPR 2021-04 Chemistry	Remove rust from hood bars and repaint hood trays	The unsightly rust needs to be remedied for better student health, safety, and experience.	This work needs to be outsourced due to the chemical resistant painting process and rust removal.
3	FPR 2021-01 Bio Cabinets	Complete the room 30-128 modifications of additional cabinets	Biology has been requesting upgrades in 30-128 since 2017, along with the chemical countertop and lower cabinets to support the expansion of Bio 120 & Bio 141L sections. The cabinet storage is not adequate for the needs of this lab.	None of the three projects have been completed due to a lack of funding.
4	FPR 2021-03 Title V Relocation	Relocate the Title V department/program to one central location	Relocating the Title V program is essential. However, there is no space for this move currently. Once Bldg 36 is completed in 2022, space may be available.	Clear student goals for space planning may help the future of this program.

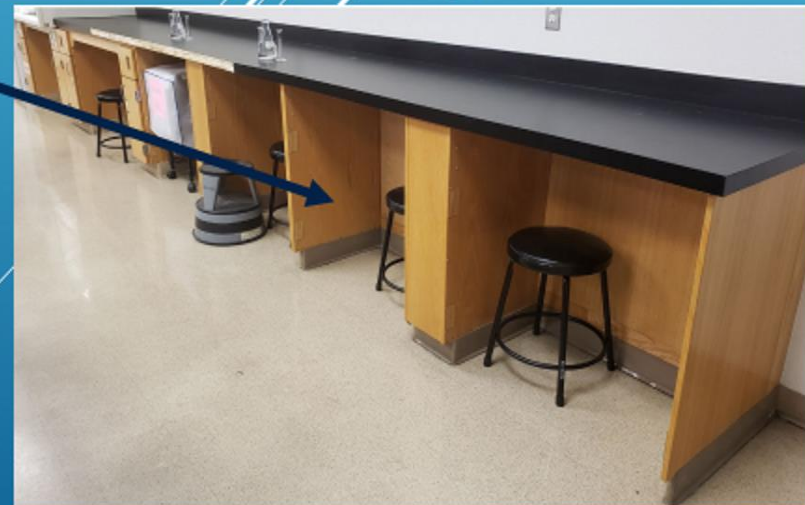
- Three chemical hoods were removed
