
## **Grossmont College's Integrated Program Review & AUP Planning Cycle**



The Integrated Planning Cycle begins with the Comprehensive Six-Year Program Review. Units report their progress on implementing their program review goals in Years 2 through 5 of the planning cycle while at the same time planning ahead by adding new goals, implementation, activities, or by making adjustments to their program goals based on subsequent analyses of data and feedback from sources such as outcomes assessments, course retention and success rates, student surveys, and other performance indicators. These reflections, analyses, and action planning activities are completed during annual unit planning in years two through five of the program review cycle. This reflection and planning may result in the need for resources to help implement program review goals and annual unit plan activities. Therefore, resource requests for staffing (classified and FT faculty), technology, facilities projects, professional development, etc. are submitted along with the annual unit plan (AUP) and/or program review report in the fall semester.
