122C (1,2,3,4,6): General Admit Student Cohort

All students who enrolled as first-time in higher education general admit credit students in at least one primary term of the selected year with a minimal credit enrollment at the selected college who are tracked for one, two, three, four and six years from first term of enrollment

GENERAL ADMIT COHORT STUDENTS

122S (D): K12 Dual Enrollment Students

The number of students who had an enrollment as a special admit currently enrolled in K12 or dual enrollment student in at least one term of the selected year
