




AB705/AB1705




AB 705 boosted student completion rates and narrowed achievement gaps by placing ALL students directly into Transfer-Level math courses.

AB 1705 furthered this work and eliminated pre-transfer/remedial math courses and is assessing the validity of prerequisites for "Gateway" courses like Math 180:



MIND OVER MATH


- Collaboration between Mental Health and Math
- Visits by a Mental Health Counselor in all support courses
- Topics include: Stress Management, Mindfulness & Meditation,
 Text Anxiety, Self Care, Stigma, Sleep Hygiene, Digital Wellness
- Emphasizes equity to meet students where they're at and challenge cultural expectations
- Destigmatizing Mental Health has led to an increase in students seeking help

- Cohort of GC Athletes taking Math 160+060: Elementary Statistics with support
- Strong partnership with the Dean of Athletics, an Athletic Counselor, and a passionate team of Math instructors

- Purchased 35 Chromebooks for student use





CALCULUS + SUPPORT M180+080

- Spring 2024
- Calculus I (M180) linked with a support course
- Increases access to the "Gateway" Calculus course
- Lowers prerequisite to: Algebra II and 3.3+ GPA
- Pilot course is encouraged by AB1705 and the CCC
 - Chancellor's office
- Funded by AB1705



USC EQUITY MINDED TEACHING INSTITUTE

- Spring 2024
- Semester long program, Eight 3 hour sessions
- Focus on embedding racial equity in teaching practices
- Create inclusive classroom cultures
- Read and interpret instructor level data by race/ethnicity
- Use race conscious self assessment tools to gauge how classroom policies affect minoritized students
- Conduct peer classroom observations with an equity lens
- Funded by AB1705
