Adopting Open and Equitable Resources - Lara Braff / Nadra Farina Hess

In the context of rising textbook costs and mounting student debt, Open Educational Resources (OER) and Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) courses offer no cost, innovative opportunities to engage instructors and students in teaching and learning. We will clarify what constitutes OER and ZTC, how to find these resources, and how to avoid using plagiarized material. In this workshop, we focus on how ZTC supports equity-minded and antiracist initiatives in two main ways: by enabling student access to all materials needed to succeed and by allowing instructors to adapt materials to create culturally sensitive and antiracist content. Participants will leave the workshop with a clear understanding of how to find, select, and edit content to best fit their pedagogy and curriculum.

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
