FEDERAL WORK STUDY WORKSHOPS

Congratulations! You have been awarded Federal Work Study for the 2021-2022 award year. Work Study is a part-time job working for an office or department at Grossmont College. Students with Federal Work Study eligibility must make an appointment for a group interview through the Financial Aid Office for job placement within 15 business days of the award notification. ***Failure to respond and schedule a placement interview within 15 business days of your award will result in your Work Study award being cancelled permanently for the award year.***

At the workshop you will learn what positions are currently available and can be referred to the appropriate supervisor for an interview. If you are selected for a position, you will also begin completion of the forms necessary for placement and payroll procedures. *Space is limited so be sure to sign-up at the Financial Aid Office for one of the interview sessions listed below.* The interview sessions last one hour and begin promptly.

If you participated in the Federal Work Study Program last year (2021-2022) you do not need to attend the workshop, but you still need to schedule an individual appointment with Jessica Lee. Please call the Financial Aid Office for a Continuing Federal Work Study appointment within 15 business days of the award notification if you received Work Study for the prior year.
