- · Each participant is allowed up to three artwork submissions depending on size and complexity of artwork, and gallery spatial constraints.
- · Exhibit entrants will be contacted following the entry deadline with additional artwork drop-off information and an exhibition contract,
- · All artwork must be framed, if necessary and ready for installation upon delivery.
- · 30% of any sale will be given to the Hyde Art Gallery's GCCCD foundation account,
- · The Hyde Art Gallery reserves the right to reject any submission,
