## **II. ORDER OF BUSINESS**

### **A. Options and Ideas for Student Benefit stickers Joseph Anthony Cruz | 30 minutes (discussion)**

Joseph spoke about the lack of items included for the ASGC benefit sticker. He spoke about including discounts, information regarding Bus passes: Student \$57.60 & Adult \$72. Try to achieve 30% discount on Bus passes. Joseph spoke about interest in discounts at the bookstore and cafe (\$5 discount on minimum \$20 purchase). Sara spoke about how we can entice the benefit sticker for the benefit of us. An example was thinking about options, like a free small soda, cookie, cold foam, like add-ons or coupons. Valerie Reyes brought up that on the website it states monthly free giveaways, yet states coming soon! The board discussed starting and solidifying what the giveaways are and what it includes. Joseph stated on deleting the ASGC scholarships from the website to not create false views. Add 2 free transcripts to the benefit center. As for parking permits, it cannot be added. Khaley Kaesser stated before Irene retired, they had money to purchase Regal movie tickets; it would be general tickets that can be sold by ASGC at a discounted rate. Sara will email Joseph and send a template that can be sent to each vendor to start building up. Valerie gave insight into the list of vendors: Starbucks, Albertsons, Gym Membership, etc.

## **B. Options for Amending the ASGC Bylaws**

The Chair will open discussion on possible amendments to the ASGC Bylaws.

Joseph opened the floor for discussion about the current board. Khaley spoke about how these changes were super quick. Changes:

Reverting constitution and bylaws as to what it was. Bringing back vp of finance, vice president as president of ICC, bringing all director rolls back.
