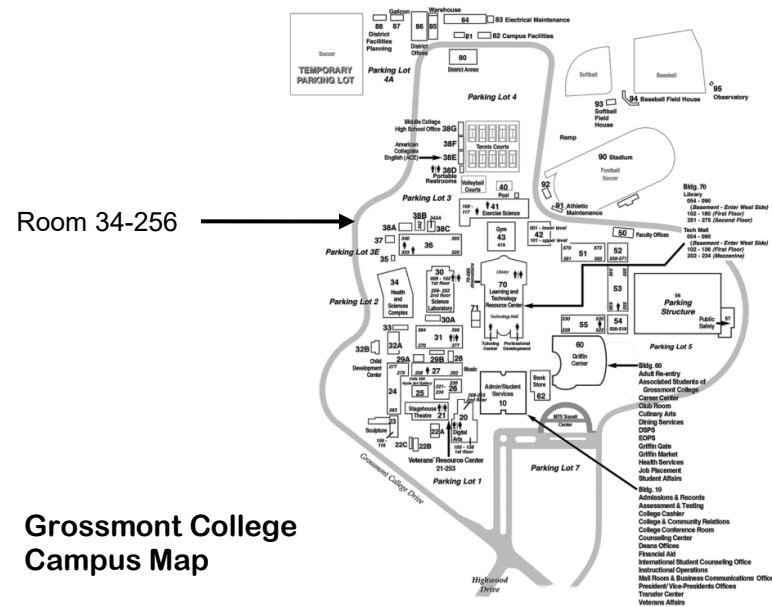

Sequence of Science Prerequisite Courses

Nursing students have one of **two** options for completing the science prerequisite courses. The prerequisite courses are either **Option I**: BIO 140, BIO 141, 141L, & BIO 152 **OR Option II**: BIO 144, BIO 145 & BIO 152. A 2.5 or better G.P.A. in prerequisite courses is required.
