- Taxes

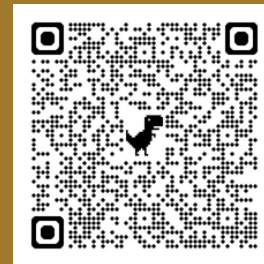
