Anthropology - B.A. DEGREE

To receive admission preference to CSU's students can complete the AA-T in Anthropology. It is also important that students incorporate as much of the lower division course work found on the www.ASSIST.org articulation agreement as possible. In addition to degree requirements, students must complete CSU GE Certification or IGETC-CSU. It is important to meet with a Counselor for additional assistance.

All courses in the major must be **completed with a grade of "C" or higher**. A "P" (Pass) grade is acceptable for courses in the major for *Associate Degrees for Transfer*.

Students applying with the AA-T in Anthropology will receive priority in the admissions process but are not guaranteed admittance into the CSU of their choice.

Admission is highly competitive for most CSU's. Students are strongly advised to go above and beyond minimum G.P.A requirements and apply for admission at multiple campuses.
