Students wishing to use a course to meet an IGETC requirement must be sure that the course is on the IGETC list during the academic year when it is taken.							
 *UC credit may be limited. (1) No credit given for an introductory course if taken <u>after</u> more advanced college course, (2) credit may be limited for courses with overlapping content, (3) duplicate credit will not be awarded for both the Honors and regular version of a course.

	requirements for IGETC. Approval of IGETC placement is done by the Articulation Officer, M. Denise Aceves, via the "Pass Along" review process. Certification is a UC admission requirement and students must request certification from the Grossmont College Office of Admissions & Records.
