In addition to degree requirements, students must complete CSU GE Certification or IGETC. It is important to meet with a Counselor for additional assistance.

* Students completing IGETC may be awarded the degree, but they must complete a course from Area 1C: Oral Communication to meet CSU admission requirements.

Title

All courses in the major must be **completed with a grade of "C" or higher or "Pass"**. A "P" (Pass) grade is acceptable for courses in the major for *Associate Degrees for Transfer*.
