To receive <u>admission preference</u> to CSU's students can complete the AA-T in English. In addition to degree requirements, students must complete Cal-GETC. It is important to meet with a Counselor for additional assistance.

All courses in the major must be **completed with a grade of "C" or higher or "Pass"**. Letter grades in the major are highly recommended, but a "P" (Pass) grade is acceptable for courses in the major of an *Associate Degree for Transfer*.
