

Grossmont College Music AA-T Preparation for the Major

Music - B.A. DEGREE

To receive admission preference to CSU's students can complete the AA-T in Music. It is also important that students incorporate as much of the lower division course work found on the www.ASSIST.org articulation agreement as possible. In addition to degree requirements, students must complete Cal-GETC. It is important to meet with a Counselor for additional assistance.

*Students who meet catalog rights and continuous attendance may utilize CSU GE and/or IGETC for their plan of study.

All courses in the major must be **completed with a grade of "C" or higher or "Pass"**. Letter grades in the major are highly recommended, but a "P" (Pass) grade is acceptable for courses in the major of an *Associate Degree for Transfer*.

SDSU accepts AA-T degrees in Music. In addition, successfully passing an audition is required for admission to the major. This major includes a language competency requirement to graduate from SDSU. Check with a Counselor for applicability to other CSU's. The Music AA-T requires a minimum 2.0 Cumulative G.P.A.

Students applying with the AA-T in Music will receive priority in the admissions process but are not guaranteed admittance into the CSU of their choice.

Admission is highly competitive for most CSU's. Students are strongly advised to go above and beyond minimum G.P.A requirements and apply for admission at multiple campuses.

The AA-T in Music is not appropriate for students wishing to apply to SDSU's Bachelor of Music (BM) major. Please refer to the SDSU Catalog for information on major preparation for the BM degree.

Students entering the BA in Music will be required to take placement examinations in music theory and piano and audition on their major instruments.

Students seeking the BA in Music are required to complete a Minor at SDSU.
