To receive <u>admission preference</u> to CSU's students can complete the AA-T in Political Science. In addition to degree requirements, students must complete Cal-GETC. It is important to meet with a Counselor for additional assistance.

All courses in the major must be **completed with a grade of "C" or higher or "Pass"**. Letter grades in the major are highly recommended, but a "P" (Pass) grade is acceptable for courses in the major of an *Associate Degree for Transfer*.

Students applying with the AA-T in Political Science will receive priority in the admissions process but <u>are not</u> quaranteed admittance into the CSU of their choice.

Admission is highly competitive for most CSU's. Students are strongly advised to go above and beyond minimum G.P.A requirements and apply for admission at multiple campuses.
