

# Connecting a Laptop to a Hotspot

- 1 Turn on Your Hotspot Device:** Turn on the hotspot by clicking the power button on the side of the device. Press and hold the button until the hotspot screen illuminates with the word "Welcome." The "Welcome" greeting will disappear, and then the screen will show the T-Mobile Logo.



- 2 How to Find the Wifi Name and Password:** Press the hotspot power button once to show the WiFi Name. Press the power button a second time to show the WiFi password. Pressing the power button a third time will return you to the T-Mobile Main screen.

- 3 Turn on the Laptop:** Turn on the laptop by pressing the power button located in the top-right area of the keyboard. The laptop should open to the computer desktop. If the computer asks you to login, use the login information taped on the top of the laptop.



- 4 Connecting to the WiFi:** Look for the globe symbol in the bottom right corner of the screen. It should be located on the menu bar.

- Click on the globe symbol to open a pop-up menu.
- Find the "pizza slice" shape. Click the arrow by the "pizza slice" icon.
- Choose the Franklin T10 Hotspot name that matches your hotspot device. Refer to Step 2 to find the WiFi Name and Password.



- 5 Enter the Hotspot Password:** The laptop will prompt you to enter the hotspot password. Type the password and press enter.

- 6 You are now connected!**



# Turn Off the Hotspot

- 1 Press the Power Button:** Holding the power button down for several seconds will turn off your device. The screen will show "Goodbye" and turn off.



# Turn Off the Laptop

- 1 Save Your Work:** Before turning off the laptop, be sure to save your documents and close all software programs.
- 2 Shutting Down:** Click the window icon in the bottom left corner of your screen. On the pop-up menu, click the power button symbol and choose the option that says, "shut down."
